

**MSAD 12
STUDENT COMPUTER AND INTERNET USE**

MSAD 12's computers, network and Internet access are provided to support the educational mission of the schools. This policy and the accompanying rules also apply to laptops issued directly to students, whether in use at school or off school premises. Students are allowed to use privately owned computers at school with prior authorization, provided that they comply with this policy and the accompanying rules.

Compliance with the school unit's policies and rules concerning computer use is mandatory. Students who violate these policies and rules may, after being given an opportunity to respond to an alleged violation, have their computer privileges limited, suspended or revoked. The building administrator shall have the final authority to decide whether a student's computer privileges will be altered, based on the circumstances of the particular case. Such violations may also result in disciplinary action, referral to law enforcement and/or legal action.

MSAD 12's computers remain under the control, custody and supervision of the school unit at all times. The school unit monitors all computer and Internet activity by students. Students have no expectation of privacy in their use of school computers, whether they are used on or off school property.

MSAD 12 utilizes filtering technology designed to block materials that are obscene or harmful to minors, and child pornography. **MSAD 12** takes precautions to supervise student use of the Internet and also educates students about appropriate use of the Internet, but parents should be aware that **MSAD 12** cannot reasonably prevent all instances of inappropriate computer use by students that may violate Board policies and rules, including access to objectionable materials and communication with persons outside of the school.

Before a student is allowed to use Internet Services, the student and the student's parent/guardian must sign and return the Student Internet Access Acknowledgement Form (IJNDB-E). The signed acknowledgement will be retained by the school and will be placed in the student's permanent record folder. The signed acknowledgement will remain in effect until revoked in writing by the student's parent/guardian or by the school, or until a new policy is implemented. It will be the responsibility of the school principal and/or designee to properly maintain these Internet access records and to create and update as needed an accurate list of all students with Internet access privileges.

Students and parents shall be informed of this policy and the accompanying rules through handbooks, the school web site and/or other means selected by the Superintendent.

The Superintendent or his/her designee is responsible for implementing this policy and the accompanying rules. Additional administrative procedures or school rules governing the day-to-day management and operations of the school unit's computer system may be implemented by the Superintendent, consistent with Board policies and rules.
